Poor growth, lack of vigor, twig dieback, pale green or yellow leaves are all symptoms of nutrient deficiency. Poor soil and soil with high alkalinity are the two principal factors that cause

nutrient deficiency symptoms. Regular applications of appropriate fertilizer at the right times each year may be necessary to foster healthy, disease resistant growth.
